The site includes a popular Top Tips for Teachers page, and instructional guides for Propellerhead's Reason software.</p>
3-6 7-10 11-12	<p data-bbox="443 909 639 945"><a href="#">Music Theory</a></p> <p data-bbox="443 994 1374 1223">Music Theory provides the user with an animated music theory tutor covering staves and scales to intervals and chords. The site includes basic modifiable visual and aural exercises, and tools such as staff sheet creator, interval and chord calculator, and popup keyboard. The material is downloadable for iPhone, iPod, and iPad.</p>
3-6 7-10	<p data-bbox="443 1330 943 1366"><a href="#">San Francisco Symphony Orchestra</a></p> <p data-bbox="443 1415 1326 1545">The user can see and hear the instruments of the orchestra, be introduced to the concepts of music in The Music Lab, or create music with the Performalator or Composerizer.</p>

The collection can be searched by KV, category, key, and editor.</p>

The site covers Sibelius, Audacity, and iPads in the classroom with free Music Technology resources e-book.</p>

Each monthly instalment features an interview and performance with a special guest.</p>

The user can click to add or subtract a tone, or spacebar to stop all tones. Clicking on the Audiotool logo gives access to a more comprehensive sample manipulation product consisting of drag-and-drop modules with moveable controls.</p>

Program-specific support materials available can be adapted for local use with any musical or theatrical performance.</p>

Also available is a quiz-creating tool that covers a variety of genres, including traditional music of non-western cultures.</p>

The material is based around the VCE syllabus with links to VCE resources, but is useful for all state curricula.</p>

The site's contents include sample band partnership agreements, copyright notices, and music studio recording agreements, as well as useful checklists for organising festivals, and music managing and publishing.</p>

Go to the Music section under the Resources link for recent research reports about funded arts programs.</p>

This site operates as a portal to many different artists and projects throughout Australia.</p>
